



Notification of Sa-Kaeo Primary Educational Service Area Office 2

Re : English Teachers Recruiting Announcement

Sa-Kaeo Primary Educational Service Area Office 2 is currently seeking for six teachers of Thai or foreign teachers to teach English program in primary school.

1. Position

- English teacher at (primary school)
Chumchon Ban-Nongwang school / in Koksoong district,
Sa-Kaeo province (1 person)

2. General Qualifications

2.1 Not younger than 20 years of age be male or female, Thai and foreign nationalities are eligible.

2.2 Not possess any of the prohibited characteristics pursuant to section 44 of the Teachers and Educational Personnel Council Act, B.E.2546 (2003) as follows:

(2.2.1) Having improper behaviour or immorality.

(2.2.2) Being an incompetent or quasi-incompetent person.

(2.2.3) Having been sentenced to imprisonment in any case,
in the opinion of the Teachers Council of Thailand,
which may bring dishonour upon the profession.

2.3 Not being disabled to the point of being unable to perform duties, incompetent or mentally unstable, and free from the following diseases:

(1) Leprosy in the contagious stage or in the stage where symptoms are distasteful to society

(2) Tuberculosis in the contagious stage

(3) Elephantiasis in the stage where symptoms are distasteful to society

(4) Narcotic drug addiction.

(5) Chronic alcoholism

4. Having a minimum bachelor's degree or other equivalent qualifications
5. Having knowledge of the teaching profession according to the knowledge standards set by the Teachers' Council of Thailand.
6. Being a person of good conduct, professional ethics, and behaving in accordance with Thai culture by having been trained by an institution that certifies the training course for Thai language teachers for foreigners
7. Having a certificate of evaluation results of the mental and behavioral state of teachers or a certificate of mental health from a government hospital

3. Specific Qualifications:

(1) Direct native speakers from the following 5 countries: United Kingdom (England, Wales, Ireland, Scotland), United States, Canada, Australia, and New Zealand.

(2) Second Language/Official Language English Speakers: Foreign nationals who use English as a second or official language, such as those from South Africa, Netherlands, Sweden, Ireland, India, Nigeria, Ghana, Papua New Guinea, Uganda, Botswana, Malaysia, Philippines, and Singapore.

(3) Foreign Language English Speakers: Foreign nationals who use English as a foreign language, such as those from China, Egypt, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, Nepal, Taiwan, Zimbabwe, and Saudi Arabia.

(3.1) Must have a standardized international English language proficiency test result (CEFR level B2 or higher) covering all four skills. The test result document must be no more than 2 years old from the date of the test.

(3.2) If holding a degree in a field other than education, must possess one of the following qualifications:

(3.2.1) TEFL Graduate Diploma in Teaching from a university with a minimum study duration of 120 hours.

(3.2.2) TKT Module 1, 2, 3, and YL scores not less than Band-3 for primary school teachers (test results must be no more than 5 years old from the date of announcement of the results)

(3.2.3) TKT Module 1,2,3 and CUIL scores not less than Band-3 for secondary school teachers (test results must be no more than 5 years old from the date of announcement of the results)

(3.2.4) TrinityTESOL Level 5 Certificate.

(3.2.5) CELTA.

4. Educational qualifications for foreign English teachers and Thai English teachers

(4.1) Minimum Bachelor's degree in English.

(4.2) Standardized international English language proficiency test result (CEFR level B2 or higher) covering all four skills. The test result document must be no more than 2 years old from the date of the test.

(4.3) If holding a degree in a field other than education, must possess one of the following qualifications:

(4.3.1) TEFL Graduate Diploma in Teaching from a university with a minimum study duration of 120 hours.

(4.3.2) TKT Module 1,2,3 and YL Band-3 scores not less than Band-3 for primary school teachers (test results must be no more than 5 years old from the date of announcement of the results)

(4.3.3) TKT Module 1,2,3 and CUIL not less than Band-3 scores not less than Band-3 for secondary school teachers (test results must be no more than 5 years old from the date of announcement of the results)

(4.3.4) TrinityTESOL Level 5 Certificate.

(4.3.5) CELTA.

(4.4) In the case of Thai English teachers, they must have a teaching license

(4.5) In the case of foreign English teachers, they must have a primary teaching license (B-License) or a teaching license (P-License), which the school can apply for after the employment contract is signed.

5. Compensation

(5.1) Direct native speakers from the following 5 countries: United Kingdom (England, Wales, Ireland, Scotland), United States, Canada, Australia, and New Zealand are considered to receive compensation not exceeding 30,000 baht per month.

(5.2) Second Language/Official Language English Speakers: Foreign nationals who use English as a second or official language, such as those from South Africa, Netherlands, Sweden, Ireland, India, Nigeria, Ghana, Papua New Guinea, Uganda, Botswana, Malaysia, Philippines, and Singapore are considered to receive compensation not exceeding 27,000 baht per month.

(5.3) Foreign Language English Speakers: Foreign nationals who use English as a foreign language, such as those from China, Egypt, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, Nepal Taiwan, Zimbabwe, and Saudi Arabia are considered to receive compensation not exceeding 25,000 baht per month.

(5.4) Thai teachers who have the specified qualifications are considered to receive compensation not exceeding 20,000 baht per month

6. Date of application

You can apply by submitting the application in person from 16th -22nd June 2025 during working hours 8.30 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. (every day) at Personnel Division of Sa-Kaeo Primary Educational Service Area Office 2. Please dress appropriately.

7. Application documents

(7.1) A copy of degree certificate or educational certificate (Bachelor's degree or higher) along with an original document and a copy of transcript of records (A degree in Education or related fields)

(7.2) An original document and a copy of valid National ID card (for Thai) valid passport and visa (for foreigner).

(7.3) Three recent photographs of 1x1.5 inch full-faced photograph without hat and sunglasses (taken no longer than 6 months)

(7.4) An original document and a copy of the change of name certificate and other documents (if any)

All documents must be certified as true copies with an original signature.

7. Application Conditions

The applicants are responsible for self-examination and certification as having general and specific qualifications for the position according to the recruitment announcement. The applicants must fill in the details and submit the correct and complete evidence for the application. In the event of an error caused by the applicant for any reason or educational qualification does not match the qualifications of the position applied for the selection, as a result, applicants are not eligible to be selected according to the candidate announcement. It shall be deemed that the application and admission to this selection are void /nullified for that person and cannot claim any rights in no case.

3. To teach the students from 7.30 a.m. until 4.30 p.m. on Monday-Friday
4. To teach the students at least 20 periods/week
5. To co-ordinate, work, and support all teachers within the classrooms and school where appropriate.
6. To give teaching resources and a lesson plan that are both creative and practical.
7. Willing to be a speaker to help Thai teachers improve their English language skills both within and outside the school when the school organizes the training.
8. Join with teachers who supervise children during English Day Camp and other school activities.
9. Join with all various creative activities.
10. Be flexible and adaptable in all job conditions. Be kind and courteous to your colleagues.
